GENERAL INFORMATION

The MP&MS After School Program is offering a variety of creative and exciting activities. We hope you will see some of your children's favorites as well as some new and exciting classes. Read through the booklet carefully and discuss the classes with your children. If you have any questions please call Matt Penwell (After School Director) at 924-2608 ex. 226, or from 2:00 to 6:00 @ 336-4611 (cell phone). All classes are filled on a first - come basis.

You may register for every activity by using the After School registration Form located in the middle of this booklet. Please make all checks payable to Marin Primary & Middle School (MP&MS). Please do not give checks to the instructor of the class. Return all payments (checks are the preferred form of payment) along with the registration form either to: Marin Primary & Middle School, 20 Magnolia Ave. Larkspur, CA. 94939, c/o Matt Penwell, or you may hand deliver them to MP&MS secretary Donna Vaught by no later than **September 1, 2006**. Once you have enrolled for Day Care and/or Electives, you have one week to cancel your registration for a full refund. **After one week, no refunds.**

Students are enrolled in the After School Program when the After School Registration Form has been signed (with payment attached) and returned to Donna Vaught, or Matt Penwell. If you decide not enroll your child in the After school Program, but instead, want to have Day Care on a drop-in basis then you will be billed at the rate of \$10.00 per hour. To use Drop-In, simply call Matt Penwell @ 924-2608 ex. 226, or 336-4611 and leave a message stating that your child will be staying for After School. Drop In hours will be billed to your monthly invoice statement. Use of the library by students unaccompanied by an adult from 3:00-5:00 is also considered part of the After School. Please remember to sign out your child with an After School staff person when you pick your child up from After School.

Day Care is available on the following days; Conference Days (Oct. 9 & 13, Mar. 30), Spring Break (Apr. 9 - 13), Half Days (Nov. 13-15), Staff Development (Mar. 19) and PA Speaker Series (Nov. 7, Jan. 16, Apr. 17). To sign up for PA Speaker Series child care, please use the sign up sheet located outside the office. The PA Speaker Series sign up sheet will be taken down one day before the event, so be sure to sign up early. Day Care is not offered during Thanksgiving Break (Nov. 20 - 24), Holiday Break (Dec. 22 - Jan. 5), Winter Break (Feb. 19 - 23), Staff Development (Jan. 12 & May 25), or during Half Days (Nov. 17, Dec. 22 and June 8).

CAPOEIRA

Capoeira (pronounced ka-poo-eh-da) is an Afro-Brazilian martial art that combines dance, music, percussion, song, ritual, self-defense technique, and acrobatics. It is an athletic stream of consciousness. In part it is a dance; a rhythmic dialogue with a partner set to the music of traditional instruments. In part it is a fight; a strategic match of throwing and dodging kicks, sweeps, and defensive movements.

Kids' Capoeira classes are taught using games and exercises emphasizing music and acrobatics — working both physical coordination and mental abilities. Classes cover basic capoeira techniques, rhythms, instruments, and songs in Portuguese. Classes are open to all levels. New students are welcome to start at any time.

Kids' Capoeira for Ages 5 - 7 emphasizes cooperation and spatial awareness and focuses on building basic physical skills and coordination. Students begin to learn acrobatic movements and improve balance and coordination of the arms and legs. Classes are not appropriate for children under 5.

Kids' Capoeira for Ages 8-13 emphasizes skill building and leadership, and builds strength, flexibility, and endurance. Students begin learning more complex acrobatics and sequences of movements. Children under 8 are not physically or developmentally prepared for this class.

CARPENTRY

Girls and boys 5 - 13 years old will have fun learning lifetime skills with hand tools while building many projects including toy boats, bird feeders, doll beds, go-carts, skateboards and furniture for advanced students. Besides learning very safe carpentry techniques with hammers, saws and drills, participants will gain quality experience in problem solving, measuring and applied math including fractions.

This class is designed to build basic familiarity with the principles of Math and Science

and to develop critical thinking and problem analysis and resolution. It is based on the hands-on method of theory and application, presented in real events, real testing and real results. RC CARS AND/OR MACHINES & MECHANICS

This class is taught by Al Mayberry and proved to be very successful at Marin Primary. Al provides a complete mechanics shop where kids learn to build, repair and race radio controlled cars. Al has been teaching this type of class for 10 years.

The course is more than a place to play with cars. The cars must be built from adult level kits and maintained on a daily basis. This work is fun, but very demanding. Kids must do all types of repairs to keep the cars running. These cars have steering, suspension, transmission and electronic systems that are much like real cars. They experience hard use and need fine tuning and repairs constantly. This requires quality analysis, problem solving and follow through to get a lasting repair successfully completed. Many educators believe that this type of hands-on real life problem solving develops capabilities in a child superior to those gained from academic exercises.

Cars and equipment are provided for the kids to use, but they may bring in their own cars for building and repairs. The shop is well equipped with top quality tools and cars. The price reflects the cost of the equipment. Kids may also work in the junk shop, dissecting computer components and hooking up circuits with batteries, bulbs, buzzers and bells.
