### **Radio Control Cars Zoom Through the MP&MS Campus!**

LARKSPUR, Calif. — Kids are learning to build, tune and drive radio control cars at Marin Primary & Middle School Summer Camp. “Kid’s Radio Control Car & Mechanics Class” will be offered beginning June 20 -August 17, Monday through Thursday, for boys and girls 9-16 years of age.

“The kids are learning about current high technology,” says Al Mayberry, MP&MS instructor and founder of the class. “They are not just playing games. The kids are motivated to be educated.”

The class gives an overview of basic electronic and mechanical concepts and will focus on building and racing the sophisticated world champion Losi Model Cars. These high quality cars are like miniature real cars with shock absorber suspensions and differential transmissions. Building and working with them is complex and demanding but very fun. The radio control cars cost about \$500. This class is also part of the regular curriculum at MP&MS.
